Primary School - Grades 1 to 5



We offer the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (IB PYP) for Grades 1 to 5 at OWIS. The IB PYP at OWIS is underpinned by the National Curriculum for England to implement age-appropriate learning outcomes.

Holistic and Student-Centric IB PYP Curriculum

In the IB Primary Years Programme, students learn to be proactive early on. We encourage them to think independently, ask questions about the world around them, and explore topics of interest.

We also prioritise character development by teaching timeless values and creating a safe environment for children to try new things, build self-esteem and develop a lifelong love of learning through a balanced mix of traditional and technology-driven education.

Friendly and Intimate School Environment

Teachers, students and staff contribute to our school's warm and welcoming atmosphere, making it easier for your child to adjust to their new environment. Our spacious, comfortable and well-thought-out indoor and outdoor learning spaces encourage students to explore their curiosity, develop a love of learning and feel excited about going to school every day.

Our qualified IB teachers have experience catering to different types of learners in an international setting and continuously upgrade their teaching skills. Modified Cambridge -Grades 6 to 8

Secondary education at OWIS is academically rigorous and technology-enabled, and it centres around students' well-being and their holistic development. While we prioritise academic excellence, we also support your child's personal growth so that they can pursue their interests, build confidence and acquire key skills they need for their higher studies.

In Grades 6 to 8, we follow a Modified Cambridge curriculum, which is based on the Cambridge Lower Secondary framework and has been adapted to align with our international school's context and the IB Learner Profile.

Pastoral Care

The form tutor is a key part of our Pastoral Care Programme. Students have dedicated time during the school day when they can interact with their form tutors while working on social, emotional and critical thinking activities as well as learning about mindfulness and gratitude. This helps them to build their confidence and develop a positive outlook.

Engaging Student Life

Our focus is on the holistic development of our Secondary students and not just academic outcomes. We offer an exciting programme of Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) and residentials, where our learners can develop new interests, talents and passions. Our House Competitions are adrenaline-filled events, and students learn the values of sportsmanship and teamwork. We also encourage student agency through clubs and societies, where learners who share common interests with others can hone their skills in a collaborative environment.

Secondary Student Council

Our student council is made up of representatives from both the lower secondary and the upper secondary cohorts. These students are nominated and elected by their peers through a democratic election. The chosen representatives all have a special role in promoting student voice and agency for the betterment of our school.



Secondary School - Cambridge IGCSE for Grades 9 to 10

The Cambridge IGCSE programme at OWIS aims to help students become learners who acquire the knowledge presented to them while simultaneously developing a deep understanding of the subjects studied. It emphasises the skills-based learning programme that is integral to the learning foundation at OWIS.

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB DP) at OWIS is a future-focussed pathway that allows students in Grades 11 and 12 to explore the subjects that interest them and establish a solid educational foundation for the future.

At OWIS, we strive to provide an educational environment that allows students to become lifelong learners, and as such, the IB DP perfectly aligns with our mission and values. The IB DP nurtures all aspects of a student's development, and the courses are designed to support students as they grow intellectually, physically, emotionally and socially. After graduating with their IB Diploma, students are on the right path to become well-rounded, internationally-minded global citizens.

Students who graduate from the IB DP at OWIS head to university with strong critical thinking, research and writing skills.

Our IB DP students are our student role models for the IB Learner Profile Attributes. We are firmly committed to ensuring our students flourish physically, intellectually, ethically and emotionally at OWIS.





At OWIS, your child will be guided throughout their academic journey so that they can fulfil their personal dreams, goals and ambitions. Your child will have access to our University Guidance and Career Counselling team who are deeply committed to your child's success.

Our University Guidance Team counsels students in Grades 8 to 12 and provides them with information about various career options and universities that may be of interest to them. They help them understand the specific requirements, programmes and scholarship opportunities available at these institutions.

Our University Guidance Counsellor meets with students on an individual basis to guide them in preparing their personal statements and their essay topics for their college applications. Students are provided with both practical and emotional support during this transitional time when they first start to think about their futures as independent adults.

Students who are going on to complete their National Service (NS) in Singapore or are thinking of starting a career after completing Secondary School are guided through this process by our University Guidance Counsellor.







Co-scholastic learning & ECAs

At One World International School, we have created and implemented a variety of co-scholastic learning programmes to provide a well-rounded education to our students.



We believe that learning additional languages enhances the overall educational experience. This allows students to function better on a personal and professional level, thus making them more competitive in a global economy.

At OWIS, students have the opportunity to learn Mandarin, Spanish or French as second languages. We have also introduced Japanese as a language option in Primary at all our campuses.

The Arts

We work with our students to provide them with opportunities to experience different forms of art as a medium of self-expression. From visual and fine art to drama, our students learn to apply their artistic talents in a variety of ways.

Sports

Physical education teaches students to be aware of their skills, to be confident and to learn about healthy competition as well as teamwork. Our all-encompassing sports education programme promotes activity and competition.

Music

Our music courses allow students to learn more about the process of making music and to take plenty of opportunities to enjoy music. Students



are introduced to the fundamental components of music and are also taught about the process of music development.

Outdoor Learning

Outdoor learning is about extending the learning experience beyond the classroom walls. Our students take part in field trips, residential visits and CAS activities in addition to learning in outdoor spaces as a part of their curriculum.

STEAM and Digital Learning

Our students are introduced to ICT from Primary School, and their digital skills grow throughout Secondary School. We also emphasise digital citizenship, helping them become responsible online citizens. In our dedicated STEAM studios, students also explore creativity and innovation across Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics.

ECAs

We partner with specialist providers to offer an exciting range of after-school activities. Through these classes, our students have the opportunity to enjoy courses and experiences that encourage their interests and passions.





Other Optional Programmes for Building Language Proficiency

Academic English Prep Programme

The OWIS Academic English Prep Programme (AEPP) is designed for students in Grades 6 to 8 who are new to the language and need intensive support and guidance to build on their English language competency. This new immersive, full-time programme provides students with the opportunity to focus on their English skills, along with other subjects.

English as an Additional Language Programme

The OWIS English as an Additional Language (EAL) programme is designed to provide students in Grade 1 to Grade 8 in the mainstream IB and IGCSE classrooms with the support they need to improve their English language skills. These additional lessons are conducted in small sizes and with a one-on-one approach.

Students are able to improve their understanding of the subject matter being taught in their regular lessons as well as strengthen their bonds within the diverse student community.

Chinese-English Bilingual Programme

Aligned with the IB PYP, our optional Chinese-English Bilingual Programme provides a rich, engaging and immersive learning experience for our Primary students, so that they can improve their speaking, writing and listening skills in Mandarin and English.





Learning Environment at OWIS

The learning spaces at our OWIS campuses are designed to inspire collaboration, creativity, and holistic development. Our classrooms are equipped with modern technology and flexible seating to foster interactive, collaborative learning.

Admissions

The academic year at OWIS begins in August and concludes in June. However, prospective students can apply for admission at any point during the school year. Admission into the school is dependent on the student's overall application as well as the availability within their particular grade level.

Any student who is interested in attending school at OWIS must follow the steps of the application process and complete each portion of the application form in order for their admission to be considered. At OWIS, we are committed to making sure that our application process is as straightforward and simple as possible, which helps streamline our admissions process.

Our Admissions Process

- 1. Complete application form online and upload all necessary documents, which includes past school reports and reference materials from previous teachers or carers.
- 2. Pay the one time non-refundable application fee.
- 3. We often have a discussion with new parents as well as an informal interview with the student. Assessment tests are conducted for certain grades.
- 4. To confirm the admission, a place of offer is shared with the parent that they have to accept. This confirms that we're able to offer a seat to the child.

- 5. The login details for the parent portal are shared and parents are required to generate an e-contract.
- 6. Optional Submit the registration form for school bus only if you're availing school transport.
- 7. Make payment of tuition fees.


